It is my pleasure to inform you that the Council of the American Chemical Society, at its meeting on September 9, took the following action:

"On recommendation of the Committee on Local Sectional Activities and with the endorsement of the CPC, VOTED to charter a new local section with headquarters at Murray, Kentucky, to be known as the Kentucky Lake Section and with territory comprising the Counties of Ballard, Caldwell, Calloway, Carlisle, Fulton, Graves, Hickman, Lyon, McCracken, and Marshall in the State of Kentucky; Carroll, Gibson, Henderson, Henry, Madison, Stewart, and Weakley in the State of Tennessee; and Massac in the State of Illinois, the Nashville Section having released Stewart County, Tennessee."
